Action Don to update website 1. Home page mentions next meeting is in February 2. SP is no longer the campaign coordinator

Agred two Target Wards (TWs) Only: St Peters (Naseem)and Park (Paul)

Noted Paper candidates:

Action: SP and Isabel to work on holding a stall in Queen Sq

SP to seek permission from WCC Licensing Dept.

(SP agrees to try to get general purpose GP leaflets for the stall.)

Noted: West Midlands GP officer is Karl; Isabel has his contact details.

Much concern was expressed by 2 of the 4 of us (a 3rd was ambivalent) re the Paul's poster in that it attacks Labour re Gaza. That GP does not engage in negative politics.

IG says certainly not in local elections. SP says "Ceasefire Now" would be adequate.
